I (we) as food booth vendor, agree to the following rules and regulations:

Booths must pass Will County Health Department requirements and food booth vendor must pay for the inspection fee. A blank application has been included with this contract. This form must be submitted along with the inspection fee (\$45) to the Will County Health Department at least 3 weeks prior to the Festival. Upon approval, a copy of the approved Will County Health Department permit must be provided to the Peotone Sesquicentennial Celebration Organizing Committee. All booths must abide by the Will County Health Department rules and regulations at all times. Inspections will take place on Friday, June 23, beginning at 1:00 p.m. All booths must be set up and ready for inspection at this time.

Food Booth Vendor must furnish a certificate of insurance to the Peotone Sesquicentennial Celebration Organizing Committee prior to May 15, 2006. Certificate can be mailed to the Peotone Chamber of Commerce, P.O. Box 877, Peotone, IL 60468. The insurance certificate requirements are as follows:

- The insurance company shall have a minimum Best Rating of A-1
- The minimum limit of liability shall be \$1,000,000.00
- The policy coverage shall be Comprehensive and on an Occurrence form
- The Will County Fairgrounds, Peotone Chamber of Commerce and Peotone Sesquicentennial Celebration Committee shall each be named as an additional insured and certificate holder

All Booths shall be painted. Trailers shall be in good repair.

Booths must display a prominent sign above the service window, which identifies the business/organization by name. The sign shall measure a minimum of three (3) feet long by 10 inches high.

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Disposal of grease upon the Will County Fairgrounds property is strictly prohibited. All booths must be equipped with fire extinguishers. Dumpsters will be provided for paper/product waste.

All organizations must contact a qualified electrician for the purpose of obtaining permanent wiring improvements in their booths that will be adequate for their current and future energy requirements. Hook-ups will begin no earlier than 10:00 a.m. on the opening day of the Festival unless prior arrangements are made. Emergencies after initial hook-up must be paid at the time of service.

The Peotone Sesquicentennial Celebration Committee will govern use of the facility with restricted access to the booths.

You will not be allowed to expand beyond your allotted space. You must leave your booth/trailer open until 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the Festival (Sunday).

Hours of operation are as follows:

Friday:	5:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.
Saturday:	11:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.
Sunday:	12 noon – 5:00 p.m.

Additional hours of operation before and/or after the required hours are permitted with the permission of the Peotone Sesquicentennial Celebration Committee.

Major clean-up procedures (mopping, equipment cleaning, etc) are to be done in the evening after closing rather than in the morning. All booth vendors are required to keep their space and its surroundings cleared of litter and debris. Sufficient waste receptacles will be provided for consumer paper/utensil waste.

The use of sound systems, glass bottles and loud generators are prohibited.

The types of foods offered for sale are limited to avoid duplication. The menu items approved on this application must be adhered to with no additions or deletions after the application deadline. Menus and prices are to be displayed on front of booth. Soft drinks will be allowed for sale at every booth.

All proceeds from the sale of food and beverages belong to the vendor. The Peotone Sesquicentennial Celebration Committee does not take a percentage of the profits you generate.

The Peotone Sesquicentennial Celebration Committee, the Peotone Chamber of Commerce, Will County Fairgrounds, Village of Peotone, and members, volunteers and employees thereof, will not be held responsible for any loss, damage, injury death, or otherwise in connection with this Festival. It is agreed that vendors, employees, volunteers, owners and acquaintances of any kind will hold these persons harmless from any loss, damage, injury, death or otherwise which arises from vendor's negligence.
